**POSITION AVAILABLE:** Full-time Field Liaison/Lecturer position for a 12-month appointment for the 2008-09 academic year.

**THE DEPARTMENT:** This 1.0 Field Liaison/Lecturer position is funded via federal funds from the California Social Work Education Center (CalSWEC).

**DUTIES OF THE POSITION:** Under the direction of the Director of Field, the Field Liaison/Lecturer will provide field liaison instruction for practicum experiences that geographically span seven different Bay Area counties; coordinate and manage field placements in public child welfare settings and in agencies servicing children and families; participate on various MSW Departmental committees; supervise MSW interns as needed; teach courses in the Children, Youth & Families and/or Mental Health concentration; work with agency supervisors and other CSUEB field liaisons to maintain and develop new field placements within the social work community. Field-related activities include both the Hayward and Concord campuses.

**RANK AND SALARY:** Lecturer. Salary is dependent upon educational preparation and experience. Subject to budgetary authorization.

**DATE OF APPOINTMENT:** Employment to commence as soon as position is filled.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** MSW required with at least two years of employment with a public child welfare agency; previous experience in social work administration and in teaching is preferred.

**APPLICATION DEADLINE:** The review of applications commences November 5, 2008. Position is open until filled. Those presently in the department's lecturer pool, whether teaching or not, must submit a new letter of application and a complete and current vita. New applicants must submit a letter of application, a complete and current vita, graduate transcripts, teaching evaluations, if available, copies of major publications, and three letters of recommendation to:
